

Jack Johnson Plants Trees with Surfrider Brazil, Lady Gaga Shows Her Teeth for Shark Week, And More (Video)

Wrapping up his tour in South America, <u>Jack Johnson</u> didn't leave the region without <u>showing support for the Surfrider Foundation in Brazil</u>. He planted the first Acu-Jequitib'a tree in the Botanical Gardens in Rio de Janeiro, <u>Ecorazzi reports</u>, and participated in a protest against the new Brazilian Forest Code.

According to <u>Surfrider Brazil</u>, "cutting down the tropical forests of Brazil will directly affect the protection of essential water basins, including mangrove and wetlands and all of the important biodiversity that inhabit these ecosystems, creating an unprecedented impact on the coastal equilibrium." They've launched "Surf for the Forests," a campaign supported by Johnson to create awareness around these issues.
